Parental Authorization

Except for first aid, personnel shall not dispense prescription or non-prescription medications to a child without specific written authorization from the child's physician or parent. Such authorization will include, when applicable, date; full name of the child; name of the medication; prescription number, if any; dosage; the dates to be given; the time of day to be dispensed and a signature of parent.

I give **SOECA STAFF**, permission to apply one or more of the following topical ointments/preparations to my child in accordance with the directions on the label of the container.

- Baby Wipes
- Band-aids
- Neosporin or similar ointment
- Bactine or similar first aid spray
- Sunscreen
